Dr. the Honourable Surujrattan Rambachan, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Communications received Mr. José Garcia Prieto Lemus, outgoing Chargé d' Affaires of the Republic of El Salvador during a farewell courtesy call at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Communications on 30th January, 2012.

Discussions centred on El Salvador's appointment of an Ambassador to Trinidad and Tobago in the future and this country's interest in appointing an Honorary Consul in El Salvador. In this regard, Minister Rambachan indicated to Mr. Lemus that the Government of Trinidad and Tobago was currently moving towards appointing Honorary Consuls in all countries in which there was no diplomatic presence.
